N1. Collector forms media monitoring committee in Villupuram district

The district administration has constituted the Media Certification and Monitoring Committee to keep a tab on news and features appearing in the print and electronic media ahead of the April 18 Lok Sabha elections in Tamil Nadu. The media monitoring cell was inaugurated by District [Election](#) Officer and Collector L. Subramanian.

According to a release, the committee would be responsible for certification of advertisements, monitoring of news in print and electronic media and keeping records of all election-related news of candidates in the fray. This facility would help monitor whether poll-related expenditure incurred by the candidates were properly accounted for.

The committee, headed by the District Election Officer, consists of the Revenue Divisional Officer, an Assistant Professor from Anna University, District Information Officer from National Informatics Centre, Public Relations Officer and senior journalists as members.

The committee members would verify the advertising contents sought to be published by political parties, the candidates or their supporters before releasing them to the media. Any violation of the model code of conduct by political parties would also be monitored.

The monitoring cell was equipped with four television sets, computers and recording equipment to analyse election news coverage round the clock. The committee members would monitor news channels and take cognisance of any code violations reported by the media.
